### From the airport to the congress venue: Universitätssportzentrum Schmelz


From Vienna International Airport (VIE) you have different options to reach the congress venue.


#### 1. Arrival with the City Airport Train (CAT)

-  The **City Airport Train (CAT)** takes you to the City Air Terminal **Wien Mitte/Landstraße** in 16 minutes. CATs leave the airport every half hour from 6:35 am to 11:35 pm.  
Single fare: € 11,00 at the CAT desk, CAT ticket machine or online. Tickets are only valid for the CAT.
-  At Wien Mitte/Landstraße you need to buy a ticket for the Vienna public transport system (Wiener Linien). Single fare: € 2,20 at the ticket machine or online. There are also Tickets available for 24h, 48h or 72h. ([Wiener Linien](#))  
Take the **underground U3**, direction **Ottakring** and get off at stop **Johnstraße** (take a wagon in the front of the train). Leave the underground station towards the **exit Meiselmarkt**.
- From here you can either walk (about 8 minutes) or take the **bus line 10A** direction Heiligenstadt. Exit at the 2nd stop **Schmelz/Gablengasse**. The entrance to the congress venue is located 20 meters on the right hand side of the bus station.

## 2. Arrival with the train: S-Bahn S7

1.  To get to the airport train, follow the sign “S-Bahn” in the airport arrival hall. The line S7 takes you to the station **Wien Mitte/Landstraße** in 25 minutes. S7s leave the airport every half hour from 4:56 am to 0:12 am.  
Single fare: € 4,20 at the ticket machine. This ticket includes public transport in Vienna to get to the hotel or the congress venue (single fare). There are single fare tickets and 24h, 48h or 72h tickets available.
2.  Take the **underground U3**, direction **Ottakring** and get off at stop **Johnstraße** - exit Meiselmarkt.
3. Footpath or bus to the congress venue see description and maps above.

## 3. Arrival with Airport Bus Shuttle / Vienna Airport Lines (BusVAL1)

1.  The bus station is directly in front of the airport arrival hall. Take the **bus VAL1** to **Wien Westbahnhof (Europaplatz)**. The busses leave every 30 minutes from 5:15 am to 0:15 am. It takes around 30 minutes to get to Wien Westbahnhof.  
Single fare: € 8,00 in the bus or at the ticket machine. Tickets are only valid for the shuttle bus.  
At Westbahnhof you need to buy a ticket for the Vienna public transport system.  
Single fare: € 2,20 at the ticket machine or online. There are also Tickets available for 24h, 48h or 72h.

2.  Take the **underground U3**, direction **Ottakring** and get off at stop **Johnstraße** – exit Meiselmarkt.
3. Footpath or bus to the congress venue see description and maps above.

## Public transport in Vienna

Vienna has an efficient public transportation system. Within the city limits, all tickets for public transport are valid for busses, trams and undergrounds. You can easily purchase tickets at the ticket machines in Vienna or online. For general information and different kinds of tickets: Single fare: € 2,20 at the ticket machine or online. There are also Tickets available for 24h, 48h or 72h.


